**“With God, you can live an unlimited life!”**

## **How Do You Limit God?**

### **1. Small Thinking –**

- Exchange your thoughts for God’s thoughts and think big!
- Speak a good report over your life and future.

### **2. Wrong Attitudes –**

- Having the right attitude is more important than skill.

### **3. Focusing on Obstacles –**

- When you focus on obstacles and impossibilities, your faith shrinks!

### **4. Unbelief –**

- Miracles arrest our attention but do not bring faith.
- Faith comes by hearing the word of God.
- Whatever you are facing – believe God!

### **5. Wrong Confession –**

- Confession means saying the same thing God has already said.
- Confession comes before possession!
- Start saying what God has already said in His word and accelerate your faith!

### **6. Walking by Sight –**

- Chose to walk by faith and not by sight.
- Focus on the eternal because it will not change. The temporal is subject to change.
- See yourself through the eyes of God.
- What you speak is only what God can do you in your life.
- When you complain – you remain!
- Your confession starts with your head, moves to your spirit, then into your heart.
- From the heart the mouth speaks.

## **Psalm 78:22, 41 (NKJV)**

<sup>22</sup> Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his salvation.

<sup>41</sup> Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel.

## **Numbers 14:26 – 28 (KJV)**

<sup>26</sup> And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying, <sup>27</sup> How long shall I bear with this evil congregation, which murmur against me? I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel, which they murmur against me. <sup>28</sup> Say unto them, As truly as I live, saith the LORD, as ye have spoken in mine ears, so will I do to you.

- What you speak is what God can do you in your life.
- When you complain – you remain!

## **Proverbs 18:20 (KJV)**

<sup>20</sup> A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled.

<sup>21</sup> Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

- Your mouth produces fruit.
- What you say with your mouth has consequences.
- Increase starts with your mouth.
- To flourish this year, increase will start with our mouth.
- Wash your mouth out with God's word.
- An abundant life comes by speaking life (God's word).
- Stop speaking words that are stealing your future.
- First thing out of your mouth is God's promises.

## **Numbers 13:27 – 31 (KJV)**

<sup>27</sup> And they told him, and said, We came unto the land whither thou sentest us, and surely it floweth with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it.

<sup>28</sup> Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: and moreover we saw the children of Anak there.

<sup>29</sup> The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: and the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.

<sup>30</sup> And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it.

<sup>31</sup> But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we.
